The second day, November 25, will include news from WP's, parallel flash talk discussion groups from abstracts, an interactive session, a session on emerging trials and new concepts, and a closing session with a focus on conditions for clinical research. - Affiliations
*Affiliation number in brackets, Department, Institution, City, Country.
Example: (1) Dept. of Oncology, Odense University Hospital, Odense, Denmark.*
- Abstract text
*Structured in Introduction, Materials and methods, Results, and Conclusions. One figure OR table pr abstract.
Note: Structure not required for new projects*
